## **Free Temporary Housing Option**

April 17, 2020

## Dear Colleague:

Earlier this week, we communicated several discounted hotel accommodations for Lifespan employees who risk exposure to COVID-19 at work and live with a vulnerable family or household member.

We have also been working in partnership with the State of Rhode Island to secure **no-cost** temporary housing at Brown University, which will now be available starting as early as next week.

This is a first-come, first-served dormitory housing option for health care workers who do not have the means to afford a discounted hotel room.

This housing option is **not available to people who have tested positive for COVID-19 or have related symptoms**. The State is offering separate quarantine and isolation housing to those who need a safe place to stay.

## **Free Dormitory Housing Details**

- Single-bed units with linens (blanket and towel included), floors are not genderspecific
- Gender-specific shared bathrooms
- o Reservation requires minimum of four nights per week
- Self-service laundry available, \$1.50 per load
- Free parking
- o Free WiFi
- Dining hall is open with grab and go service; cash or card accepted (limited hours)
- Must bring personal toiletries and other items, entertainment (no TVs in room),

food, pillow, etc.

## **How to Reserve**

- To request free dormitory housing at Brown University or to view available discounted hotel accommodations, please visit <u>COVID Temporary Housing</u>. (<a href="https://www.lifespan.org/covid-housing">https://www.lifespan.org/covid-housing</a>)
- o If you submit a request for the free housing option, a member of the Lifespan housing team will get back to you within 48 hours.

As a reminder, the State also established an online portal that offers discounted lodging for frontline workers throughout Rhode Island: <u>Visit RI Havens</u>.

Housing resources, including a list of professional organizations offering free rooms to members, is also on Lifespan's COVID-19 intranet site under Personal/Family Resources.

We are continuing to work hard to support your health and safety needs during this crisis.
