Dear Colleagues, As you know, we just finished negotiating a terrific contract with many improvements. We had a great bargaining team including Mike Pellicano, Doreena Duphily, Dawn Leonardo, Kathleen McGovern and Valorie Paquette.

I would like to thank the contract committee and those who turned out for the informational picket. Having more members involved made a big di erence in turnout on the picket line and membership meetings.

Last week we met with CNAs and secretaries about floating and safety issues. We will address the concerns in the float grievance meeting.

Remember the employer should have posted the holiday schedules for the year by January 15th. If the schedule is not posted let us know.

Contract Negotiations With Prospect A Success

The Service employees at Fatima voted overwhemingly at the end of 2022 to ratify a 3 year contract with improvements in differentials, health insurance, general cotract langauge and an enhanced wage scale that provided wage increases that range from 6% to 60% over the life of the contract. There are a number of employees questioning their placement on the scale based on years of experience and currently the union is processing resumes to check for accuracy.

Your local union worked with the union registered nurses at the Roger Williams Medical Center and the union employees at Prospect Chartercare Home, Health and Hospice to achieve contracts for all 3 unions.

Your Contract

The union has proofread the final contract and sent the contract to the employer to proofread. Once finished the printed contracts will be distributed to employees and posted on the UNAP website.
