



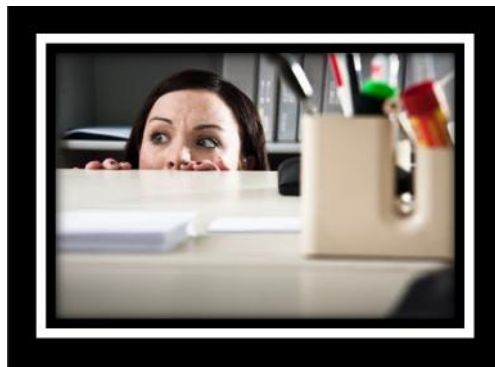

## **Where's Lynn Leahey?**

Remember when Lynn Leahey was running around the hospital last fall and winter telling all of the CNAs that she wanted to give CNAs a raise but couldn't because the Union wouldn't let her?

## **She's Nowhere to be Found!**

Well we've met with management 6 times over the last 5 months to negotiate for a new contract and she's nowhere to be found!



She hasn't showed up at a single meeting, and to this day, hasn't proposed a single penny in wage increases for the CNAs or anyone else.

The union, on the other hand, has proposed that all employees get 5% cost of living raise each year and a 4% step increase each year.

The Union has also proposed to increase the evening, night and weekend differentials, on call and preceptor pay, and create a new floating differential and 4% longevity pay increase at 30 years of service for all employees.

**So when Lynn Leahey blames the Union for not increasing the wages of the CNAs – take that with a big 'ol grain of salt!**
