I wanted to take some time and update you on some developments around the Hospital:

1. **Opening of a new ICU unit** - we have been working with a team from the Hospital to staff, train and operate a new ICU to be located on the 6th floor. Staffing has already begun and training will start shortly thereafter. This will be an open unit (meaning employees can be floated in and out of the unit) and we hope that by the end of the year it will be fully operational.

2. **Visitor Policy** - As you know, the hospital relaxed the ban on visitors to the hospital. During the first week or two after the revision, we heard of many issues with the policy. We took these concerns to management and the Hospital revised the policy. Hopefully, this will reduce the number of issues. 3. **Masking** - Please remain vigilant in masking; as more visitors come into the Hospital, it is as important as ever to make sure we all stay safe and properly mask.
